We understand the importance of conserving natural resources.  
Check out our procedures already in place to promote a  
“greener” way of life.

Green “Linen and Terry” Program is a Westin Brand Standard. This is a “passive” program meaning all guests are automatically participating and must “opt out” by either placing the “please change my linens” card on the bed, or by leaving their terry on the floor.

Recycle through Waste Management Recycling. All paper products, including phone books and cardboard. Re-cycle trash containers are located for the use of hotel associates.

Hotel Shuttle Services are available for the local area, 5 mile radius, on a first come first serve basis, at no cost to the guest.

Video Checkout and Folio review is available via the guestroom television.

Guestroom amenities, shampoo and conditioner, are produced in plastic bottles made of re-cycled materials.

Re-cycle for wooden pallets from bulk deliveries.

Re-cycle for outdated telephone directories.

Water saving flush toilets.

Light dimmer capacity in public areas, the conference center, and restaurant, in addition to windows in several meeting rooms that allow for the use of natural light for daytime events.

Sensors on all lights in hotel offices which automatically turn off the lights if there is no activity is in the room.

Fluorescent v. Incandescent for guestroom entrances and bathrooms, and all public spaces.

Occupancy sensors in guestrooms to control HVAC.

Use only real/re-useable china, silver and linens in F & B areas.

We use pitchers of water in meetings.

We re-use leftovers and over-produced food items.

We offer buffet food service.

We offer vegetarian meals on request for banquet events.

We have some interior plants/foilage.

We can perform double sided copying, and we do charge only per page.

We use re-useable kitchen towels v. disposable for cleaning in culinary production and food service areas.

We buy green label/non-mercury fluorescent bulbs.

The hotel is about 80% fluorescent, only in guestroom lamps and a few others do we have incandescent.

We replace the toilet flush mechanism annually to reduce leakage.

We use Ecolab non-phosphate chemicals in all areas, laundry, housekeeping and engineering.

The conference center HVAC is computerized allowing for power savings during off periods.

The guestroom bathroom sinks have standard aerators.
